FOUNDATION OF FAITH – LESSON #1.

ADVERSITY AND FAITH – LESSON #2.

Key verse: James 1:2, "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;"

Read passage: James 1:2-12; March 14.

INTEGRITY AND FAITH – LESSON #3.

Key verse: James 1:17, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."

Read passage: James 1:13-18; March 21.

THE SCRIPTURES AND FAITH – LESSON #4 (FRIEND DAY).

Key verse: James 1:22, "But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."

Read passage: James 1:19-27; March 28.

HUMILITY AND FAITH – LESSON #5.

Key verse: James 2:10, "For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all."

Read passage: James 2:1-13; April 4.

FOLLOWING AFTER FAITH – LESSON #6.

Key verse: James 2:24, "Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only."

Read passage: James 2:14-26; April 11.

OVERCOMING THE TONGUE – LESSON #7.

Key verse: James 3:2, “For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.”

Read passage: James 3:1-12; April 18.

RIGHTEOUSNESS IN CONFLICT – LESSON #8.

Key verse: James 3:18, “And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.”

Read passage: James 3:13-18; April 25.

EXAMINING RELATIONSHIPS – LESSON #9.

Key verse: James 4:4, “Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.”

Read passage: James 4:1-6; May 2.

NEARER TO GOD – LESSON #10.

Key verse: James 4:7, “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”

Read passage: James 4:7-10; May 9.

SENSITIVE TO GOD’S WILL – LESSON #11.

Key verse: James 4:15, “For that ye ought to say, If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that.”

Read passage: James 4:13-17; May 16.

INVESTING IN OTHERS – LESSON #12.

Key verse: James 4:11, “Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.”

Read passage: James 4:11, 12; 5:1-12; May 23.

CONFESSING ALL SINS – LESSON #13.

Key verse: James 5:16, “Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.”

Read passage: James 5:13-20; May 30.
